REASONS TO CALL

1. Gush of fluid/steady trickle of fluid from the vagina.
2. Six or more painful contractions/hour (not Braxton-Hicks)
for two hours despite rest and hydration **prior to 36 weeks.**
3. Bright red vaginal bleeding or passing blood clots.
4. Pain or burning with urination.
5. Decrease in fetal movement.
6. Severe abdominal or back pain.
7. Severe headache, not relieved by Tylenol.
8. Blurred vision, or other visual changes.
9. Persistent vomiting or unable to keep anything down for 24
hours.
10. Fever >100.4F or 38C
